Tax Free Childcare

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).

If you get Tax-Free Childcare, you'll set up an online childcare account for your child. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay your provider.

Follow the link to check your eligibility:

You can set up and account online, transfer money into the account, the government will top it up and then you can pay your nursery fees through the account. Lots of you already pay using your Tax Free account, but there are lots of you who don't take advantage. You may be registered through a different Tax-Free Voucher scheme which is through your employer.
