

Flying Start Preschool Fees 2022/2023

Flying Start Pre-School has fixed operating charges for two age groups which are calculated annually on the actual cost of provision.

The Government Early Education funding for 3 & 4 year olds is for BASIC childcare with a staff ratio of 1:8 children, parents are charged separately for the additional services, enhanced ratios, snacks, consumables and extra-curricula activities and the many other features of the Flying Start provision.

There is an additional £10 charge per child per year to cover Staff Training days.

We will offer the 15 hours (universal entitlement) funded early education for 3- & 4-year-olds, which will entitle you to a maximum of 15 hours childcare per week for 38 weeks of the year, the term after your child becomes 3.

September 2022 for children born 1st April – 31st August 2019, **January 2023** for children born 1st September -31st December 2019, **April 2023** for children born 1st January – 31st March 2020.

Since September 2017, the government introduced the **extended entitlement** which is an additional 15 hours to some working families, usually called the **30 hours funding**. Parents need to meet the eligibility criteria and further details of how to claim are on the Surrey County Council website. <u>30 hours funded childcare for working parents - Surrey County Council (surreycc.gov.uk)</u>

We offer 5-hour sessions per day, therefore we are currently only able to offer a <u>maximum</u> of 25 hours per week (15hrs universal & 10hrs extended funding).

- You can choose to take the funded hours with more than one childcare provider
 Children staying for a 5 hour sessions will need to bring in a packed lunch, mid-morning snack is provided on every session.
- We accept Tax Free childcare vouchers.
- Nursery fees are payable termly in advance by BACS or childcare vouchers, these can be
 paid in two instalments; 50% on the first day of the half-term and 50% on the first day of
 the second half-term.
- Please note fees are still payable if your child is absent due to holidays or sickness.
- Half a term's notice should be given in writing to Flying Start on the first day of term if you wish your child to leave the Pre-School.
- Extra sessions rarely become available throughout the year, however you can extend your child's session to 2pm even on the day.

Daily fees for 2 year olds and for children not eligible for the 3 & 4 year old Government Early Education Funding.

For 2 year olds a minimum of 2 sessions a week must be attended.

You may choose to have different sessions during the week.

Daily fees for Universal (15 hours) & Extended Entitlement (30 hours)

For 3 & 4 year olds, a minimum of 3 sessions a week must be attended.

You may choose to have different sessions during the week.

9.00am - 12.30pm £10.96 per session

3 ½ hour session

9.00am - 2.00pm £15.65 per session

5 hour session

Fees over the Universal funded entitlement of 15 hours per week are charged at £8.00 per hour.

If claiming for the 30 hours funding (you will need to apply for this in advance) the fees above will apply (we offer a maximum of 25 hours)
