Phonics

This week we started to introduce letter names and sounds at carpet time. Our letter of the week has been 's'. The children have practised making the sound sssss, writing it in the air and fed the snake objects that started with the sound s. You can continue this at home by pointing out the letter s out and about, asking if objects start with the sound and practising to write the letter s. To make writing more interesting, try dusting some flour in a tray and invite your child to write the letter 's' with their finger.

School Places

Our school leavers should have all received their school place by now. On our notice board is a sign up sheet to add your child's name to the school they will be attending in September. If your child's school is not listed, please add it. It helps us to know which school the children will be going to so we can talk about their new school, look at photos and encourage friendships.

School Preparation

This term we start our school preparation sessions. These are in addition to the daily skills the children learn. To start off with the children talked about going to school, how they feel, recapping the value of independence and taking shoes off and putting them back on again. These sessions are not about learning letters and numbers, but important skills such as independence, confidence and self-care. 
